Prepare For Overnight Camp

Packing Checklist

- ___ Sleeping bag or linens for single mattress
- ___ Pillow
- ___ Two Towels (One for shower, one for water activities)
- ___ Toiletries (___soap, ___ toothpaste, ___toothbrush, ___shampoo, etc)
- ___ Socks and undergarments for a week
- ___ Two pairs of shoes (one good for activities that can get dirty, paintball, horseback riding, hiking, etc)
- ___ Water shoes (for the river, avoid flip flops)
- ___ Clothes for paintball, long sleeves, pants, camo, etc (Sr. action weeks only)
- ___ Sweatshirt and jeans (in case it gets cold)
- ___ Shorts and t-shirts (no short shirts/shorts or spaghetti straps for girls, please)
- ___ Rain gear
- ___ Plastic bags for wet / dirty clothes
- ___ One piece swimsuit (if it's high cut bring shorts to wear on top) / swimming trunks
- ___ Bible
- ___ Flashlight

Do Not Bring

- Items harmful to your child or others (Knives, weapons, lighters, fireworks, etc.)
- Electronics (collected on first day of camp and returned last)

Drop Off and Pick Up

Monday Check-in is 4:00-5:00 PM Come meet the counselors and settle your camper into their cabin. Camp begins officially with dinner for staff & campers at 6:00pm. Camp gates open at 4:00pm.

Saturday Pick-up is 10:00 AM Families can join us in the dining hall for our closing ceremonies. Campers will be dismissed immediately after at 10:30AM

The camp store will be open at drop-off and pick-up. (Cash or card)

Stay Connected

Emails are handed out daily during dinner. Please limit your messages to one per day as to not overload our printer. Email camper@longviewranch.com with your campers name / day of the week in the subject line.

Care packages may be left in the office to be given out mid-week (no bigger than a shoe box). Great items for a care package are: glow sticks, bandanas, resealable snacks, sports drinks, notes from family members, battery-powered mini spray fans, silly bands. Bad items for a care package are: candy with wrappers, any food item that is not in a sealed container, electronics, sling shots, toy guns, etc.

Pictures of camp are posted online during the week. You will be emailed access information once your camp session begins. We make every effort to capture each camper during the week so please be patient with us.

Health Info

Over the counter and physician prescribed drugs will be kept with the camp nurse, and will only be administered by the health staff. All over the counter and prescription drugs must be in the original container.

Policies

- All medical and release forms, plus the remaining balance, are due 4 weeks prior to the starting date of the camp week enrolled.
- If you cancel your camp registration within 1 week of your scheduled arrival at LVR, you will be responsible for full tuition cost unless a spot is filled by a new camper registration. The deposit is non refundable in this case.
 - Please notify LVR as soon as possible regarding cancellations to open the spot to another child.
- Campers who must leave due to sickness or emergency will be allowed a refund of \$25 per day not at camp.
- LVR reserves the right to dismiss any camper without refund if their behavior is harmful to other camp participants, our staff, or our facilities.

Other Info

- One camp t-shirt is included in camp tuition.
- Camp videos are free and will be available for download in the fall.
- LVR has a "no electronics" policy during the camp week. Please leave cell phones, mp3 players, gaming devices, tablets, and anything else electronic at home.
- The camp store is open during the week at free time. Campers may bring money with them to spend, or parents can add money to their account during registration online. Items range from \$1-25; snacks are available.
